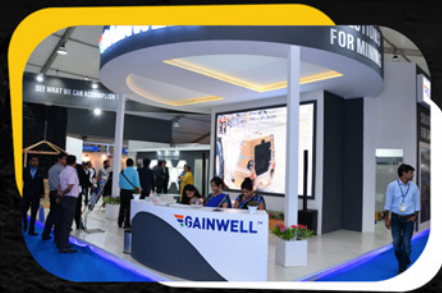

The MSME preferential tariff is applicable for Indian companies only. The MSME certificate should be submitted for availing the benefit. This is inline with CII's policy on enabling MSME's.

Co-Exhibitors : A Co-Exhibitor is defined as the group compaines and Subsidiaries who shall choose to exhibit in the booth of main exhibitor. Co-Exhibitor is eligible for One Page Catalogue listing, Participation Letter, Exhibitor badge and a Catalogue Copy. Participation fee is Rs 5000/- (or) USD 75 will be applicable for each Co-Exhibitor (Taxes Extra)
